



Several members have voiced concerns about suggested prices for puppies, which is happening amongst all breeds. In line with several other breed clubs the committee would like to suggest that the members adopt a breeders charter. Should we decide to adopt a charter this can be displayed at regular intervals on the FSS facebook page to make people aware of how the Society feels about indiscriminate breeding practises ?

Field Spaniel Society Breeders Charter.

You may be asked to pay a deposit to be placed on a short list

- a) No deposit taken prior to a litter being born
- b) No deposit taken place prior to a puppy buyer visit

No more than 2 litters bred in a calendar year by this breeder

Parents should be Hip Scored, Eye Tested it is also recommended that Field Spaniels used for breeding are elbow scored.

Breeders should also be encouraged to include heart testing.

Dam must be at least 18 months of age at time of mating

Breeders are recommended to sell all pups at a fair and equitable price. (2026 guidelines £1900- £2000).

Health test results should be made available to all prospective puppy buyers.

Any breeder displaying this charter is proud to uphold these principles.
